IGNOU Launches Certificate Programme for Nurse Managers to Strengthen Managerial Competencies in Nursing Services

The six-month programme will help participants:

- Apply modern management principles in nursing service administration.
- Collaborate with ancillary departments for seamless hospital/clinical operations.
- Plan and supervise staff recruitment, training, and development.
- Manage resources efficiently within departments.
- Participate in accreditation, quality assurance, patient safety, and nursing audits.

As hospitals and healthcare institutions increasingly focus on **nursing excellence standards and quality benchmarks** such as NABH accreditation, the role of Nurse Managers has expanded to include strategic planning, decision-making, and quality governance. This certification addresses these evolving needs by building capacity among nurse leaders across public and private health systems.

- In-service nurses with 3-year General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) after 10+2, 3 years of experience, and valid RNRM registration OR
- In-service nurses with 4-year B.Sc. Nursing degree, 2 years of experience, and valid RNRM registration
