Rules framed by the University for resolving the Tie-up cases: In respect of the candidate scoring same marks / rank, the tie will be resolved as under:-

a) Qualification: The overall score secured by the candidate in qualifying examination at post graduate level and then at graduate level will be considered in following order:

- i). Two marks will be given for post graduation with 50% marks.
- ii). One mark will be given for graduation with 50% marks.
- iii). If still there is a tie-up, then preference should be given to higher percentage of marks in **graduation level**

b) Age: If tie up still exists, then date of birth of the candidate in the descending order i.e. the candidates born earlier will be ranked higher than the one born later.
